Econet – European Constitucional Network

ECONET is an open network, aiming to promote research and cooperation between the partners and with other universities, centres of research, institutions and private entities. The coordination of Econet resides in the University of Szczecin.

ECONET started the Summer Schools in 2008 and participated in the creation and development of the Joint European Master in Law and Policies of European Integration, which awarded joint official degrees between the Autonomous Universities of Barcelona, Milan, Montpellier and Szczecin.

One of the activities that ECONET is developing so far is EUROGLOS, devoted to a multicultural glossary of European constitutional law, with the participation of 11 partners, namely:
